WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we B. B. Lynch and E. J. Lynch
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full
do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said H. Claude Williamson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Sevier Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot Three (3) Block Three (3) Grand Addition to City of
Suba and Lu.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said H. Claude Williamson and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said H. Claude Williamson that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, E. J. Lynch, wife of the said B. B. Lynch for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said H. Claude Williamson all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
