KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. L. Smiley and Alice R. Smiley, his wife and I. E. Smiley  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and seventy five \$575-00 DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by H. Claude Williamson, the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged.

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said H. Claude Williamson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Review Addition to the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot (3) Three in Block (16) Six according to the recorded plat of  
Review Addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said H. Claude Williamson and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said H. Claude Williamson that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice R. Smiley, wife of the said J. L. Smiley and for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said H. Claude Williamson all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
