

QUIT CLAIM DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 11th day of March A.D., 1907 between Haskell B. Tally and a single man his wife of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, party of the first part, and Edwin B. Tally of Forrest Tenn party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred & fifty dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the Cherokee Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

An undivided one 1/6 interest in Lot seven (7) of Section thirty five (35) Township twenty (20) north range twelve east containing twenty nine & five one hundredths 29.05 acres.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.
