

## QUIT CLAIM DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 24<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D., 1907 between Oscar S. Mason and Arta Mason his wife of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, part of the first part, and Francis M. Wilder of Idaho Det. party of the second part,

witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar dollars,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the

Town of Skiatook Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot eight Block twelve (12) in the town of Skiatook Indian Territory according to a plat made by J. H. Patton on the south east quarter of Section 23, Township 22 north Range 12 east; This deed is made to correct an error in a special warrant deed dated April 13, 1905 wherein the grantor herein convey to grantee herein the lot above described and which was recorded April 17, 1905 in Book 8 Page 18 of Claremore Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Arta Mason wife of Oscar S. Mason and Lucy S. Stout wife of the said William C. Stout

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Francis M. Wilder all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
