WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Joseph E. Smith and Hattie J. Smith  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by L. D. Marr  
do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said L. D. Marr and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
The south half of the south half of the North west  
quarter of section (32) thirty two, township (20) North  
and range (14) fourteen east of the Indian Base and  
meridian in Indian Territory containing 40 acres

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said L. D. Marr and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said L. D. Marr that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Hattie J. Smith, wife of the said Joseph E. Smith for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said L. D. Marr all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
