QUIT CLAIM DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, h^{is} heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title,
interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in
the Creek nation Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:
