

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 30th day of July A.D., 1907 between George W. Adams and Minnie E. Adams his wife of Tulsa Indian Territory, District, party of the first part, and Kate Steen of Tulsa I.T. party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollars,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the Creek nation Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

The south west quarter of the north west quarter and the east half of the west half of the south west quarter and Lot 2, and the west half of the east half of the south west quarter of the south east quarter and the west half of the south west quarter of the south east quarter and the east half of the east half of the south east quarter of the south west quarter of section 4, Township 15 north Range 13 east.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Minnie E. Adams wife of the said George W. Adams

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Kate Steen all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
