KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

 in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said J. F. Pantler and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the western Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all her right title and interest in and to the
south-west quarter (44) of the north-west quarter
1/4 of Sect (22) in Township 17 north Range 14 east
and the west half (42) of the south-west quarter
1/4 of Sect (13) in Twp 17 north Range 13 east amounting to
20 acres more or less, the allotment (exclusive of homestead) of
her deceased husband J. F. Pantler
 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. F. Pantler and unto his heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S. with said J. F. Pantler that she will forever warrant and de-
 fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lilla Brown, wife of the said J. F. Pantler for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. F. Pantler all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
