witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in

the Cherokee Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

The North Half of South West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Thirty-two (32) Township Twenty (20) North Range Thirteen (14) East and the South West quarter of the South West quarter of the North East quarter, Section Twenty one (21) Township Twenty one (21) North Range Sixteen (16) East and all other lands that do may have secured an interest in through a lease made on or about the 20th of July 1907 made by Joseph E. Smith to me

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said part of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.
