witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollars,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and  
by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, h heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title,  
interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in  
the City of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:  
Lot 44 in Block one Hundred and Twenty-four (124)  
In City of Tulsa, Indian Territory according to Government  
survey and plat thereof

This deed given to correct a former deed dated June 25th, 1903  
When as Frank P. Bennage appears as grantor, When Viola  
B. Bennage should appear as grantor.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right,  
title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said part of  
the second part, h heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Frank P. Bennage husband  
wife of the said Viola B. Bennage

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George B. Fowler country  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
