

# QUIT CLAIM DEED 6531

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 23rd day of September A.D., 1907 between Carl C. Magee and Grace G. Magee his wife of Lucas, Indian Territory, Western District, party of the first part, and Frank A. Leovy of Lucas, Indian Territory, party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollars,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents does release, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

Lots six (6) and seven (7) Block Three (3) Tract 8 Gillette Addition to Lucas, Creek Nation, Western District, Indian Territory.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Grace G. Magee wife of the said Carl C. Magee,

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank A. Leovy all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
