KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we W. J. Little and Minnie J. Little
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Hundred and no DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. H. Schooley and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the town of Collinsville Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
all of Lot four (4) in Block fifty-one (51) in
the town of Collinsville Indian Territory
according to the United States Government
Plat and Survey of the said town

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. H. Schooley and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. H. Schooley that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Minnie J. Little wife of the said W. J. Little for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. H. Schooley all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
