# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we T. H. Reeves and Isabella Reeves  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five Hundred & no/100 DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Mrs M. J. Blidsoe and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Western Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The east sixty (60) feet of Lots three (3) and four  
(4) in Block, forty-two (42) Original town of  
Tulsa allowing for the deviation of the townsite  
from the true meridian

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mrs M. J. Blidsoe and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mrs M. J. Blidsoe that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, F. H. Reeves, wife of the said Isabella Reeves for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mrs M. J. Blidsoe all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
