OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Robert A Crowell and Amelia K. Crowell  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand DOLLARS,  
in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged and confessed

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Raisa F. Morley & Augusta M. Morley and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot five (5) and ten (10) feet of even width off of the  
south side of Lot 117 all in Block one hundred and sixteen  
(117) in the town of Tulsa, Ok., having a frontage of twenty feet  
on south Cincinnati Ave and a depth of One Hundred  
forty feet to the alley line on rear of said lot with a  
uniform width of 30 feet being parallel to and adjoining the  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Raisa F. Morley & Augusta M. Morley and unto their  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Raisa F. Morley & Augusta M. Morley and the survivor of them  
to defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Amelia K. Crowell, wife of the said Robert A. Crowell for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Raisa F. Morley & Augusta M. Morley and the survivor of them  
all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
