

QUIT CLAIM DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 1st day of November A.D., 1907 between M B Shutt and Liddie M Shutt his wife of Tulsa Indian Territory, western District, party of the first part, and Chiss Childers of Tulsa I T party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar dollars, and other valuable consideration in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the crumpation Indian Territory, western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit: Lot five (5) and six (6) and the south half (1/2) of the north west quarter (1/4) of section five (5) Township nineteen (19) north range fourteen (14) east

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Liddie M Shutt wife of the said M B Shutt

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Chiss Childers all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
