

# QUIT CLAIM DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 9<sup>th</sup> day of Sept A.D., 1908 between Paul B. Paliaferro  
Alice R. Paliaferro his wife of Indian Territory, Western District, party  
of the first part, and C. B. Lynch of Tulsa Ind. Ter. party of the second part,  
witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One \$100 dollars,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and  
by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title,  
interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in  
the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, Western Judicial District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot seven (7) Block One hundred + sixty nine (169)  
according to "Official Plat" and Government Survey of City  
of Tulsa Creek Nation Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right,  
title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of  
the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Alice R. Paliaferro  
wife of the said Paul B. Paliaferro  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. B. Lynch  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
