# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That we W Lyle Dickey and May W. Dickey  
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Sixteen Hundred (\$600.00) DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by Morris F. Knight the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged  
do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Morris F. Knight and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south fifty feet of Lot numbered  
in Block numbered one hundred  
and fifty-two in Tulsa I.T. according to the  
Government plat thereof allowing for the  
deviation of the townsite from the true merid-  
ian

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Morris F. Knight and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Morris F. Knight that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, May W. Dickey wife of the said W Lyle Dickey for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Morris F. Knight all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
