to him in hand paid by Morris F. Knight the
receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Morris F. Knight and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The north fifty feet of Lot numbered
six in Block numbered one hundred and
fifty two in Tulsa IT according to the Government
plat thereof allowing for the deviation of the
townsite from the true meridian

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Morris F. Knight and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Morris F. Knight that he will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____, wife of the said _____ for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____ all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
