

COMPARED

QUIT CLAIM DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 8th day of November, A.D., 1907, between Nancy Dobb
and Dock Dobb, her husband, his wife of Indian Territory, District, party
of the first part, and Walter Siphiller of Indian Territory, party of the second part,
witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollars,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and
by these presents do remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title,
interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in
the Cherokee Nation Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

The east half (64) of the northeast quarter (164) of section nine (9)
Township twenty-one (21) North, range thirteen (13) east of the Indian
Base and Meridian, Cherokee Nation I.T. containing 1/2 acre more or
less according to the Government Survey thereof.
Being the allotment of Stella Tingley, deceased.
It being our intention to convey all the right, title or interest we
may have in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right,
title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said part of
the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Dock Dobb husband
wife of the said Nancy Dobb
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Walter Siphiller
all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
