

QUIT CLAIM DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 28th day of October, A.D., 1907, between J. L. Harnage and Veronica Harnage his wife of Tulsa County, Oklahoma District, party of the first part, and State of Oklahoma of Tulsa County party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the Tulsa County, Oklahoma District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

The west one half of the northeast quarter and the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section (10) ten township (12) north, range (12) east and the south (20) twenty acres of lot (14) four of section (4) four, township (19) nineteen north, range (10) ten east and the west one half of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section (16) sixteen township (19) nineteen north, range (12) twelve east, containing 160 acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Veronica Harnage wife of the said J. L. Harnage

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

State of Oklahoma, all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
