in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and
by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title,
interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in
the Green River Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

The west one half of the northeast quarter and the northeast quarter
of the northeast quarter of section (10) ten township (18) north, range
twelve east and the south 2 acres of lot (4) four of section (4) four township
(19) nineteen north range (10) ten east and the west one half of the
northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section (6) sixteen
township (19) nineteen north range (12) twelve east containing 160 acres
more or less

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right,
title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of
the second part, heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Harry E. Riley
wife of the said Walter C. Haffner
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Walter C. Haffner

all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
