# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Lena Friend and Chester V. Hamilton  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid by Chester V. Hamilton, the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Chester V. Hamilton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot six (6) in block one (1) in the Hager addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the filed plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Chester V. Hamilton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Chester V. Hamilton that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lena Friend, wife of the said Chester V. Hamilton for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Chester V. Hamilton all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
