

QUIT CLAIM DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 29th day of October A.D. 1906 between one thousand nine hundred and six between Charles M. Hurlbut of Okmulgee Indian Territory his wife of Indian Territory District, party of the first part, and George C. Beidlesman of Okmulgee Indian Territory party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable consideration dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has revised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and does by these presents does realise, convey sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, h/p heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the Indian Territory, District, and known and described as follows to-wit:

One half of all my interest in and to the south east quarter of section eighteen (18) Township nineteen (19) North and Range fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and meridian in the Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said part of the second part, h/p heirs and assigns, forever.
