OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. E. Warren and Alice M. Warren
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars DOLLARS,
in hand paid by J. W. Whitney the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. W. Whitney and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot no six 6, in Block no three (3) in
the Bellview addition to Tulsa Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. W. Whitney and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. W. Whitney that he will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Warren wife of the said J. E. Warren for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. W. Whitney all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
