WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That we James Chambers an single man  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$900.00 DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. G. Smith and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North fifty (50) acres of the North Half (N 1/2) of the North  
West Quarter (N. W. 1/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Twenty-one (21)  
North, Range fourteen (14) East.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. G. Smith and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. G. Smith that I will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, \_\_\_\_\_, wife of the said \_\_\_\_\_ for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said \_\_\_\_\_ all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
