OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Martin L. Harris and Lucinda C. Harris
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Carrie M. Wilson, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Carrie M. Wilson and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
The West Half (W 1/2) of Lot Five (5) in Block No. One
Hundred and Ninety Nine (199) in the City of Lusk, Indian
Territory according to the Government Survey and Plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Carrie M. Wilson and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Carrie M. Wilson that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lucinda C. Harris, wife of the said Martin L. Harris for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Carrie M. Wilson all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
