# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we I, Frank A. Haver and a single man  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty four Hundred and 00/100 DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid by Rachel C. Vanderwoort the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged.  
do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Rachel C. Vanderwoort and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Lot fifteen (15) and sixteen (16) in Block One (1) in  
Surveys Addition to said City of Tulsa, according to the  
duly recorded plat of said Addition;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Rachel C. Vanderwoort and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Rachel C. Vanderwoort that I will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Rachel C. Vanderwoort, wife of the said Frank A. Haver for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank A. Haver all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
