KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

Cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. B. Farr and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Town of Dawson Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

lots 4-5-6 & 7 in Block (32) a subdivision of the E 1/4 NW 1/4
S 8 1/4 Section 27 Twp 20 Range 13

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. B. Farr and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. B. Farr that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Coral G. Brink, wife of the said Elliott A. Brink for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. B. Farr all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
