OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That I, Martha Maharkey, now Red a widow
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by H. P. Moore, the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged:

I, H. P. Moore do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said he and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Brick Station Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The Northwest quarter (1/4) of the Southwest quarter (1/4) of
section Twelve (12) Township nineteen (19) North Range Twelve (12) East,
the same being the homestead allotment of Mahaley Maharkey,
deceased.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said H. P. Moore and unto his heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said H. P. Moore that I will forever warrant and de-
 fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Martha Maharkey, wife of the said H. P. Moore, for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said H. P. Moore all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
