KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. Frank C. Giddings and annexed
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred \$1500. DOLLARS,
To me in hand paid by Nancy Littlejohn

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Nancy Littlejohn and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Block No. 13 in Highlands Addition to
Tulsa, I. T. according to the Plat thereof filed and of Record
in the office of the Recorder for the 28th Recording District.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Nancy Littlejohn and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Nancy Littlejohn that I will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

except as to a certain oil and gas lease dated Nov. 19/1906.

And I, Frank C. Giddings, wife of the said Nancy Littlejohn for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Nancy Littlejohn all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
