OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John C. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred seventy five DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Margaret Cornelius and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) and seven (7),
Block Seventy Six (26) West Tulsa Indian Territory according
to recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Margaret Cornelius and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Margaret Cornelius that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John C. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Margaret Cornelius all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
