OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Henry Lytal and Rena M. Lytal
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,
in hand paid by W. M. Robbin, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said W. M. Robbin and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Station Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lots numbered two (2) and three (3) in Block numbered five
(5) in the Standard Addition to Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the
official survey and records plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said W. M. Robbin and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. M. Robbin that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Rena M. Lytal, wife of the said Henry Lytal for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. M. Robbin my all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
