OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. H. Swan and Gertrude S. Swan  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred & 00/100 DOLLARS,  
in Land paid by Amanda J. Taylor the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Amanda J. Taylor and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
all of Lot no four (4) in Block no one hundred  
eighty one (81) in the town of Tulsa Ind. Ter; accord-  
ing to the official plat and survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Amanda J. Taylor and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Amanda J. Taylor that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Gertrude S. Swan, wife of the said J. H. Swan for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Amanda J. Taylor all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
