WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Susie White, nee Walker and Dawes Roll No 13619
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to us paid by Robert Jordan and G. W. Armstrong,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Robert Jordan and G. W. Armstrong and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Reconing Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: all my right title and interest
the same being an undivided interest, as shown in and to the estate of John Walker deceased, said land being
situated in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, and described as follows, to-wit: 1/4 of Sec 14 and 1/4 of Sec 14
of NE 1/4 and 1/4 of SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 and SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of NE 1/4, section 36, Tp 21 N. R. 12 E. being
in all 90 acres, together with all other lands held by John Walker, Dawes Roll No 136, described as follows:
The SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec 2 Town 26 range 20 E. and E 1/2 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 and S 1/2 of NW 1/4 of the
NE 1/4 of Sec 6 Town 24 range 16

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Robert Jordan and G. W. Armstrong and unto their heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Robert Jordan and G. W. Armstrong that I will forever warrant and
defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Susie White, wife of the said Robert Jordan for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Robert Jordan and G. W. Armstrong all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
