KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we M. E. Cline and Mary Cline
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand, DOLLARS,
See hand paid by R. M. Stone receipt of which is hereby ac-
knowledge and confessed do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said R. M. Stone and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot Six (6) in Block Two (2) Bliss Addition to the City of Tulsa,
Indian Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said R. M. Stone and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. M. Stone that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary Cline, wife of the said M. E. Cline for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. M. Stone my all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
