KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Fifty \$50.00 DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by M. C. Bline, the receipt whereof is hereby  
confessed and acknowledged, do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said M. C. Bline and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered six in Block numbered Two in Blis's  
addition to Tulsa, according to the official plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said M. C. Bline and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said M. C. Bline that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Margaret Hagler, wife of the said J. D. Hagler for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said M. C. Bline all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
