OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we S. R. Lewis and Elizabeth B. Lewis  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by Ernest Cockrell receipt of the same  
being hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Ernest Cockrell and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Cherokee Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The east one half of the north-west quarter of the  
south-east quarter and the south-west quarter of the north-  
west quarter of the south-east quarter and the south-west  
quarter of the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of Sec-  
tion Eighteen (18) Township Twenty-two (22) north, Range Thirteen (13)  
East, being 40 acres more or less, as the case may be,  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Ernest Cockrell and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ernest Cockrell that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Elizabeth B. Lewis, wife of the said S. R. Lewis for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ernest Cockrell all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
