OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Nancy J. Williamson and widow
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS,
(\$550.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Bertha Wallace and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot 120 (2) in Block 120 (2) in the Grand Addition to the
City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the official survey
and recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Bertha Wallace and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenanted with said Bertha Wallace that she will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Nancy J. Williamson, wife of the said Nancy J. Williamson for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Bertha Wallace all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
