OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we W. H. Pound and Mary E. Pound
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of forty five hundred and no.00 DOLLARS,
in hand paid to us by William B. Scott, the receipt whereof is
here acknowledged. do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said William B. Scott, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
all of Lots (5) and (6) in Block Thirteen (13) in Range Addition
to the said city of Tulsa according to the record plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said William B. Scott and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William B. Scott that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever, except two mortgages against said premises, one
for \$1800 and one for \$200, the payment of which the said William B. Scott
assumes. And I, Mary E. Pound, wife of the said William B. Pound, for and in consideration of the said sum of

money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said William B. Scott my all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
