WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Henry Homacher and Belle Homacher
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five hundred (\$3500.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. S. Hagler and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the County of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots 7-8-9 in block five (15)
Lots 4-5-6 in block four (14) in the Trinch addition to the City of Tulsa, Okla.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. S. Hagler and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. S. Hagler that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Belle Homacher, wife of the said Henry Homacher for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. S. Hagler all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
