WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Lora E. Metheny "single woman" and
 his-wife, for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred & fifty ^{no} 100 DOLLARS,
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to me paid by H. M. Lynch
 do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said H. M. Lynch and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Original Town of Lawton ^{Indian Co. Okla} Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot twelve (12) block eleven (11) and South sixteen (16) feet of lot eleven (11) Block
eleven (11) and North Thirteen (13) & 7 1/2 inches (13 ft & 7 1/2 in) of lot ten (10) block eleven (11)
according to Recorded plat of City of Lawton of 5.

To have and to hold the same unto the said H. M. Lynch and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said H. M. Lynch that she will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____, wife of the said _____ for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____ all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
