KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John M. Holland and Anna A. Holland  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred <sup>no</sup> 100 DOLLARS,  
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us paid by W. W.  
Hinterberger do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said H. H. Hinterberger and unto \_\_\_\_\_ heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa Co. Okla. Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Our undivided one half interest in and to, Beginning at the north West  
corner of lot six (6), running South twenty (20) feet; thence East fifty feet (50); thence  
North twenty (20) feet; thence West fifty feet (50) to the place of beginning in block  
eight six (86) according to the survey - Official plat of Tulsa (N.P.) also Okla. Sell our interest  
thence South 10 feet lot two (2) Block nineteen (19) North Tulsa Okla (ST)

To have and to hold the same unto the said H. H. Hinterberger and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said H. H. Hinterberger that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Anna A. Holland, wife of the said John M. Holland for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said H. H. Hinterberger all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
