WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Myron E. Brown and Jessie M. Brown
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
in hand paid by George J. Jenkins the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged and confessed do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said George J. Jenkins and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the city of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot one (1) block four (4) Base addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma
according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said George J. Jenkins and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George J. Jenkins that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jessie M. Brown, wife of the said Myron E. Brown for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George J. Jenkins all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
