WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John E. Mills and Eclipse M. Mills
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and twenty five DOLLARS,
in hand paid by T. L. Robinson the receipt of which is hereby ac-
knowledgeed do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said T. L. Robinson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot No six (6) Block No ten (10) of Lindsey's second addition
in the town of Tulsa Ind. T., according to the official plat and
survey now on file in the U.S. District Clerk's office

To have and to hold the same unto the said T. L. Robinson and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said T. L. Robinson that I will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Eclipse M. Mills, wife of the said John E. Mills for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said T. L. Robinson all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
