WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. J. Harbour and F. J. Harbour
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred DOLLARS,
cash on hand paid by A. S. Harbour the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said A. S. Harbour and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered six (6) in block numbered one (1) in
Harbour's addition to the town of Tulsa, Indian
Territory according to the certified plat thereof on file in
the office of U. S. District Clerk at Tulsa, I.T.

To have and to hold the same unto the said A. S. Harbour and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said A. S. Harbour that that will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, F. J. Harbour, wife of the said J. J. Harbour for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. S. Harbour all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
