WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Maryne Sullivan a single and woman
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Ella Homer and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Tulsa Co. Okla. Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

North nine and 6/100 of Neash ten and 6/100 of lot three
of Sec. seven (7) Township eighteen (18) North Range thirteen (13)
East

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ella Homer and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ella Homer that she will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ella Homer, wife of the said Maryne Sullivan for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ella Homer all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
