KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John O Mitchell and Alice M Mitchell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty five 2011.00 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by P. A. Ling the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said P. A. Ling and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the town of West Tulsa Creek Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of lots number seven (7) in block number twenty four
(24) situate in West Tulsa Creek Indian Territory
according to the recorded plat filed thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said P. A. Ling and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said P. A. Ling that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M Mitchell, wife of the said John O Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said P. A. Ling all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
