**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we James M. Gillette and a single man  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred twenty five (\$625.00) DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid by R. L. Redholz and W. O. Long, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged I do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said R. L. Redholz and W. O. Long and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot three (3) in block three (3) in the Friend and  
Gillette addition to Tulsa, Western District, Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said R. L. Redholz and W. O. Long and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. L. Redholz and W. O. Long that their will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
