WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. M. Killette, Minnie M. Killette, J. M. Hall, Jennie S. Hall, J. H. Hucker and
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and fifty (550) DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by John F. Conklin, receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said John F. Conklin and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot seven (7) and twenty (20) in block nine (9) in
the Killette Hall addition to the City of Tulsa Oklahoma,
according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said John F. Conklin and unto they heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John F. Conklin that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever, except one oil and gas lease held by Grant C. Stephens or

J. M. Hall wife of the said J. M. Hall, and Carrie S. Hucker wife of the said J. H. Hucker.
 And I, Minnie M. Killette, wife of the said J. M. Killette and Jennie S. Hall for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John F. Conklin all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
