# WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Henry Hatch and Lizzie K. Hatch  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred DOLLARS,  
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged  
do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. J. Donnelly and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the town of Shiatook, Tulsa Co., Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot twenty three & twenty four (25 & 24) block eight (8) according  
to the survey & plat of city of Shiatook, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. J. Donnelly and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. J. Donnelly that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lizzie K. Hatch, wife of the said Henry Hatch for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. J. Donnelly all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
